## Behaviour Culture at St. Martins

#### Your school day



- Once you cross the RED line, all pupils must be wearing full school uniform.
- Three core values: Be Kind. Be Safe. Be Responsible.
- Skirts must sit on the knee.
- Trousers must be mid-grey.
- Trainers, fake nails, fake lashes must not be worn.
- No mobile phones to be used after crossing the red line.
- No pupil can use the toilet during the first or last 15 minutes of a lesson unless you have a toilet pass for medical reasons.
- \*NEW FROM THIS TERM\* N block toilets are closed and R Block toilets are for Year 7 and 8 ONLY. South Block Y9, 10 and 11.

#### **Detention System:**

- Break and lunchtime subject detentions set by the subject teacher.
- Pastoral break (KS3) and lunchtime (KS4) detentions for late to lesson and uniform infringements.
- ALL after school detentions will run on a Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday in S004.
- Late to school = 20 minute detention after school the same day.
- Missed after school one hour detention = Isolation.



## Behaviour Culture at Lunchtimes<sub>St</sub>

#### Assembly, Lunchtime and Astro

You must enter assembly in silence, remain in silence, sit in alphabetical order and wear full school uniform.

On your allocated day, if you work hard in lesson and complete all of your tasks your teacher may wish to dismiss you 5 minutes early for lunch. **This is at the teachers discretion.** 

If you want to use the astro on your allocated day you **MUST wear trainers**, **be actively participating (no spectators) and MUST NOT take food onto the astro**.



### Drugs

- All non-medical drugs on school premises are unacceptable.
- St Martin's will educate its pupils about the dangers of drugs through PSHE, Science, assemblies, school nurse, visiting groups and guest speakers.
- Vaping and vapes are not allowed on the school premises or as a member of the school community.
